## TERMS & CONDITIONS

**ENTRY:** The entry fee is paid only once, you may fish 1 day or 2 days and must attend the weigh-in. A 2 day pass to the Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show will be given to each adult, children under 16 are free. Entry fee must be paid before Friday 17 May 2024 in order to be eligible for weigh-in on the first day of the tournament, Saturday 25 May, 2024.

- (a) All Bream must be weighed on official scales provided by organisers to be eligible.
- (b) All Bream presented to the scales must be alive and in good health.
- (c) No undersize fish to be weighed-in.
- (d) No more than 3 Bream per team can be weighed-in per day.
- (e) Weigh-ins will be conducted on Saturday 25 & Sunday 26 May at 2pm.
- (f) All Bream caught must be taken on rod and reel.
- (g) Bait & lures can be used in this competition
- (h) All fishing regulations must adhere to the rules and regulations of the Queensland DPI. All fish caught must be within size and bag limits.
- (i) Only (1) team can win (1) major prize
- (j) Any fish deemed to have been caught more than 24 hours prior to the competition commencement in the opinion of the official judges would be disqualified. Note THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

**FRAUD:** Any evidence of fraud such as a fish deemed to have been caught more than 24 hours prior to the competition commencement, fish transported from other than offshore and inlet waters of the GOLD COAST and boundaries below, netted fish, or any action in defiance of the rules and goodwill of the competition will be placed in the hands of the Police.

**BOUNDARIES:** Fishing boundaries are from Jumpinpin to the Weedons Crossing in the Nerang River including tidal waters to the east and west of those designated areas. Fish sanctuaries cannot be fished along with the waters in Sanctuary Cove.

**PRIZES:** 1st prize: \$2,000 cash. Winning team must have the heaviest weight of Bream combined for the two days.

Random prize draws consist of a Garmin sounder, Shimano Sedona Fishing Combo's with braid, Shimano Sienna Fishing Combo's with braid, Terminal tackle, lures and tackle bags from Shimano and variety of \$100, \$250 and \$500 Anaconda gift cards. All teams will receive an entry pack consisting of fishing shirts (x2), stubbie holders (x2), Anaconda Gift Cards and soft plastic lure pkts valued at over \$250.

**LIABILITY:** The competitors nominated note that Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show accepts no liability for any injury, loss, damage to any person or their property during the competition, whether such injury or loss is due to any act, neglect or default of Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show or of any official or agent thereof and all competitors fully understand that in so participating, they do so entirely at their own risk.

**FISHING TIMES:** First day of fishing will start 6am Saturday 25 May, with the weigh-in commencing at 2pm. Last day of fishing will start 6am Sunday 26 May with the final weigh-in commencing at 2pm.

### WEIGH-IN PROCEDURE

All vessels must be in the fish weigh in line-up in the marinas designated corral at 2pm. Any vessel that is not in the line up to be weighed in at 2pm will be disqualified...no excuses. Once your team number is called out, you must come to the marked dock to weigh-in. 5 boats will come forward at a time. All boats MUST stay together prior to your team number being called. Once you have weighed-in, you must leave the marina. The last day will see all boats remaining in the corral area after the official weigh-in has been completed for the winner to be announced.

### VESSELS:

- (a) All vessels must have current Queensland registration or registration recognised in Queensland and must have the registration numbers displayed on both sides of the vessel.
- (b) Boat skippers must be the holder of a Queensland speedboat driver's license or a boat license recognised in Queensland.
- (c) All vessels must carry all the safety equipment as required by the Queensland Marine Regulations.
- (d) Commercial fisherman & commercial vessels must participate as recreational fisherman, adhering to all rules and regulations that apply to recreational fisherman & their vessels.
- (e) Any fish caught during the competition is prohibited to be sold and remain the property of Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show.
- (f) Vessels must display the SCIBS flag to enter the 2knot waiting zone for weigh-in.
- (g) Vessels must depart the marina upon completion of weigh-in and on the 2nd day after winners have been announced and received their prizes.

### BAD WEATHER:

Being an inshore event, the competition will go ahead and is up to the skipper of the team to stay in protected and safe waters.

### JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

- (a) Reference book will be E.N. Grant's Guide to Fishes 2004 Commemorative 10th Edition.
- (b) THE MANAGEMENT SHALL HAVE THE ABSOLUTE RIGHT TO EXCLUDE ANYONE FROM THE COMPETITION WITHOUT GIVING ANY REASON WHATSOEVER.

**NOTE:** Any action, incident or situation not covered by the rules and conditions written in this Entry Form shall be determined jointly by the organising committee of the SCIBS 2024 Live Bream Shoot Out and the Official Judge if or when those conditions arise. Their decision is final.

The competition requires a minimum of 12 teams to be registered and paid by 5pm Friday 17 May to proceed. Should this number not be achieved, then registered ANGLERS will be notified of cancellation immediately.
